RE: 2022-23 Texas Financial Education Endowment Grant Recipients

Austin, Texas – Twelve organizations have been awarded funding through the Texas Financial Education Endowment. The endowment is funded through assessments on credit access businesses statewide and is administered by the Finance Commission of Texas. It is designed to support and promote statewide financial capability, education, and responsibility.

Tweleve organizations were awarded an aggregate amount of \$409,000.
